Background Information:	<p>On 9 Aug 2019, at 5:25 pm, Endeavour Hills Men's Shed <endeavourhills.mensshed@gmail.com> wrote:</p> <p>Hello Rosalie and Amanda</p> <p>The EHMS Committee has requested that a meeting be held to ensure that impetus is not lost to the EHMS project.</p> <p>I refer to our meeting on 25 June. That meeting concluded with the agreement that we were to have met in the first week of August to discuss a revised 'concept plan' for the Shed and how this would fit 'budget wise'. That meeting has not been held.</p> <p>Matters which Council Officers were to have were to have taken into account for that meeting includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Soil test results (completed in July)

- EPA requirements for the foundations and slab (early indications were that gas emission levels were low and a membrane may not be required)
- Our list of possible cost reductions
- The example of Portland Shed (completed under \$300,000)
- Possibility of solar provision (roof strengthening)
- Eave height to allow for possible skillion extension
- Copy of revised layout plan.

When we asked where things are at, in respect of that meeting, we received the following reply:

'It will be difficult to revise the concept accurately until we know the full budget allocation for the project. As we are anticipating (with our fingers crossed for you) that some grant funds to be incorporated into the total budget.'

'Do you know the date that you are expected to hear the outcome of your Men's Shed State Government Grant application? Could you please send through the timeframe.'

1. In relation to the first paragraph. This does not reflect the outcome of our August meeting. There are a number of significant issues which we believe could reduce the probable costs to well below budget.
1. In relation to the second paragraph. The concept plan and budget revision entails considering the above dot points which could have a significant bearing on the probable costs and, therefore, the budget. There seems to be no reason to delay considerations until October, when grant outcomes are due to be announced.

The Committee does not understand why there is a need to delay considering these issues. The Committee is also concerned that a delay will mean that the stated deadline for selecting a tender before the end of this year will not be met.

Can you please request a meeting so that the revised plan and budget can be considered, as agreed, at our July meeting.
