Endeavour Hills Shopping Centre Promotion




On 16th and 17th November we will be manning a table promoting our Endeavour Hills Men's Shed.

Colin our newest member has also offered to revamp our EHMS promotion leaflet. Colin is in the centre looking into space.


The Java Tiger
