
Parks Victoria (PV)

Dandenong All Holden Car Show on 18th March 2018





- The RCEH Golf Day where a speaker from the Men's Shed will address the golfers. The RCEH will make a substantial donation to our building fund.






After all that business we had a presentation by Stan on tracing your ancestry and the various programs available. Somerset house in the UK is a major source of information on UK persons.
