Thursday 21st September Rudi's Bike Ride to Berwick – meet at 10.00 am

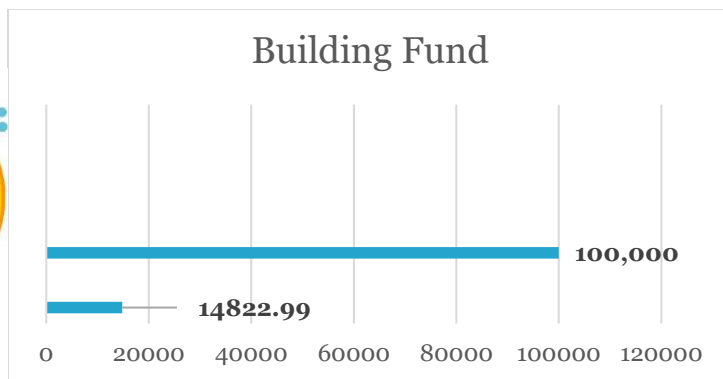
