- Two sets of Bocchi Balls will be purchased for the EHMS by John Thornton.


Ivan has retired from full time preparing the BBQ for lunch at our meetings.

#### Parks Victoria (PV)

Negotiations continue with PV and they are currently working through the options and requirements for a site at Lysterfield Park. President Trevor has suggested a planning scheme amendment to PV which will enable a Men's Shed to be on PV Land. A meeting between PV and City of Casey to be held re the planning scheme amendment. PV is also working with the City of Casey to form a Committee of Management for the Sydney Parteger Reserve.
