Data Presentation by John Thornton

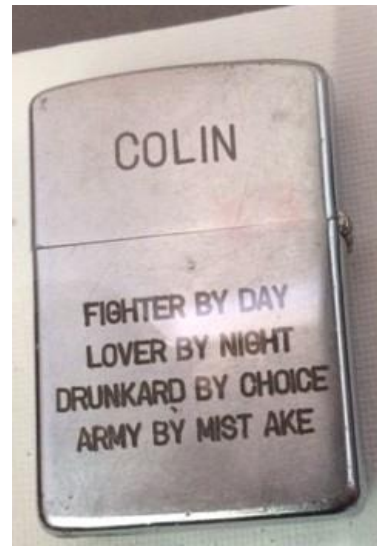
Our member John gave an excellent presentation on data, what it is and how it can be used. Quote from John referring to data use:

Letter size is 150mm for caps and 100mm for rest.

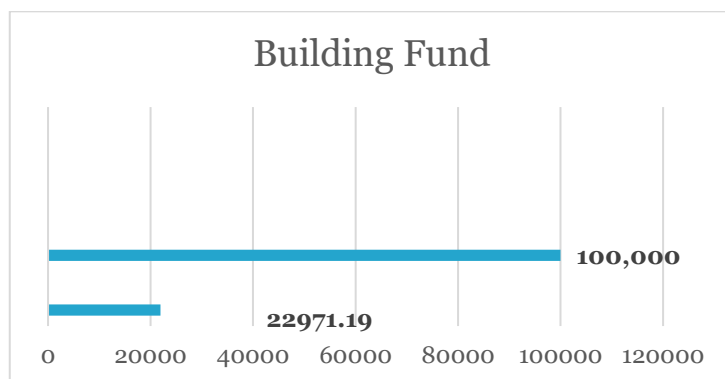
These would then be mounted on a sheet to hang or on an A frame.
