Visit to the Victorian Desalination Plant at Wonthaggi




A group of 10 members and one would be went to the plant in 3 cars. One of which decided to do 3 laps of Wonthaggi before meeting the others at the plant.



The building is very well landscaped and blended into the background with a roof garden growing local native plants.

After pretreatment the saline water is pumped through the desalination membranes at 6.5 Bar. (see left)

The process can deliver 150 Gigalitres per year of drinking water from seawater at 3.7% salt.



Following what was a really interesting visit the group made its way, without getting lost, to San Remo where we had a late lunch at the fisherman's Co-Op'

Letter size is 150mm for caps and 100mm for rest.


These would then be mounted on a sheet to hang or on an A frame.
