At the meeting the RCEH annual report was presented to members, below is an extract relating the EHMS.

Endeavour Hills Men's Shed

In the second half of the 2016/7 year the RCEH formed the Endeavour Hills Men's Shed (EHMS) this was at the time supported by a local councillor.

The EHMS with the support of the RCEH has continued to grow to 33 members and has a very active schedule of visits and other group activities including:

- Shooting at the Spring Rifle Range
- > Bay Fishing
- Walking Group
- ➤ Bicycle group

The men have also undertaken works for Parks Victoria repairing outside tables and benches at Cardinia Reservoir and the Churchill National Park. The men have also built playground equipment and bird boxes for local schools.

Whilst all this has been happening the Committee have been focused on locating a permanent site for the EHMS. In excess of a dozen sites have been presented to the City of Casey for consideration all of which have been declined for one reason or another. The EHMS is now working with Parks Victoria, the City of Casey and the local member Luke Donnellan in attempts to find a permanent site,

Meanwhile they have been fundraising by having BBQ, s at Bunnings Dandenong South, the RCEH Car Show and have a Father's Day raffle.

The RCEH has been very generous with donations to the EHMS.

The capital fund for the building of a shed currently stands at \$35008.00.

The EHMS is trying to negotiate a lease and licence for part of the community centre at Essex Park Drive in Endeavour Hills, for a period of 3 years. To date the EHMS has not accepted what is thought to be unreasonable conditions demanded by council.

In summary the EHMS has amassed a large amount of woodworking and other tools and is eagerly looking forward to finding a permanent site and completing fund raising and grant applications in order to build a permanent men's shed.

Meanwhile they are also attending various cluster meetings and Heads of Sheds. Several members of the RCEH are also members of the EHMS.

These would then be mounted on a sheet to hang or on an A frame.


The signboard is in our storeroom.
