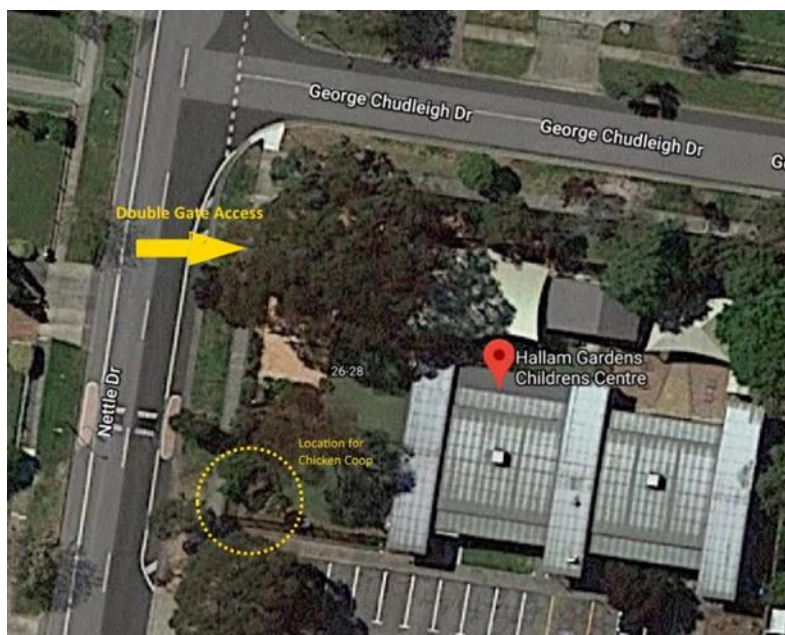

HALLAM GARDENS KINDERGARTEN – CHICKEN COOP – INVESTIGATION

8th August 2018

- Graeme Seymour and John Thornton met with Jo on-site at the Kindergarten.
- Site for chicken coop was outlined.
- Space is greater than 3m x 4m (12m² approximately), not rectangular due shrubs and landscaping.
- Council has been approached to provide fencing for the chicken run.
- Jo has existing relationships with local businesses for donations (e.g. Bunnings).
- Graeme mentioned possibility of funding EH Rotary.
- Space for 4-5 chickens, children to “pet” chickens, children to collect eggs.
- Design of coop will depend on fencing, if provided, and its type.





Last week's meeting

The meeting began with a welcome to the new potential members who came as a result of our table at the Endeavour Hills Shopping Centre where we canvassed a petition and sold raffle tickets for our building fund.

President Trevor described the purpose and functions of the club and the need for a permanent home. Also, relationships with local preschools and the Endeavour Hills Library enquiry.

Following a follow up meeting with council officers last Tuesday the committee have been considering the lease at Essex Park Drive which council have agreed will be for 3 consecutive days. Also, our approach to Parks Victoria now that we have established that the area of Sydney Parteger reserve will be under their management.

Dromana is building a new men's shed, 288m² at estimated cost of \$180,000, using new techniques. The building is not lined but fully insulated.

The RCEH is undertaking some work at the Andrews Centre and Harry has requested help from the men's Shed, as Harry is o/s Martin Pater will be the contact.

Some work and workers have been organised on Friday 17th August ?

Grant from the City of Casey

We have received a further grant for \$3000.00.

- Tools & Equipment for community projects \$2,350.00
- Portable Sound System \$500.00
- Social Activities \$150.00

The sound system is to replace the one that we have on loan from Rotary.

Letter size is 150mm for caps and 100mm for rest.

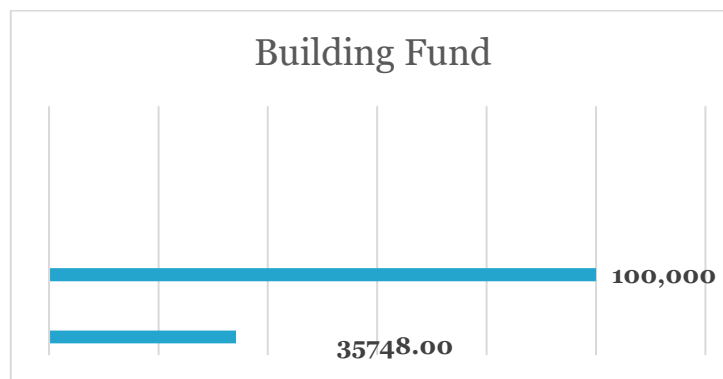
These would then be mounted on a sheet to hang or on an A frame.
