Peter Ramsbotham demonstrated how to take a bike apart and mend a puncture in a tyre.



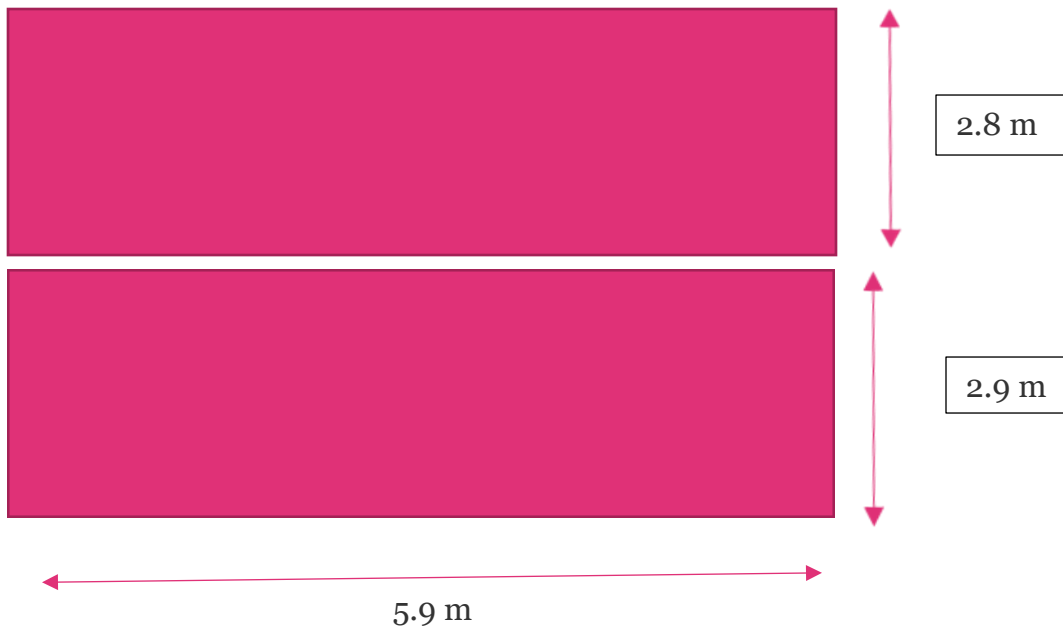

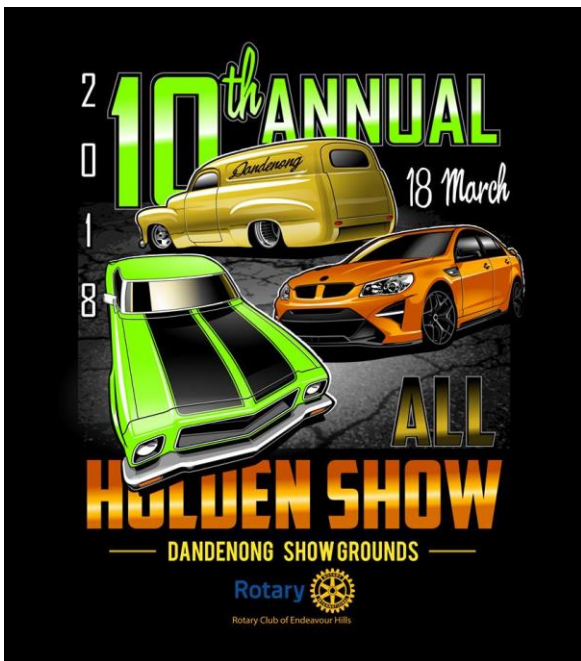
Attached are some bits that I have to layout the word Hills, now I wonder if my fellow members would like to add to this to make up Endeavour Hills Men's Shed.

Cardinia Reservoir

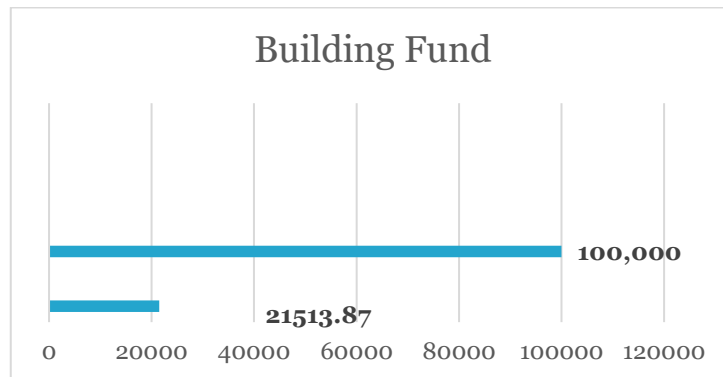
Work is now complete repairing the outdoor furniture in the park.
