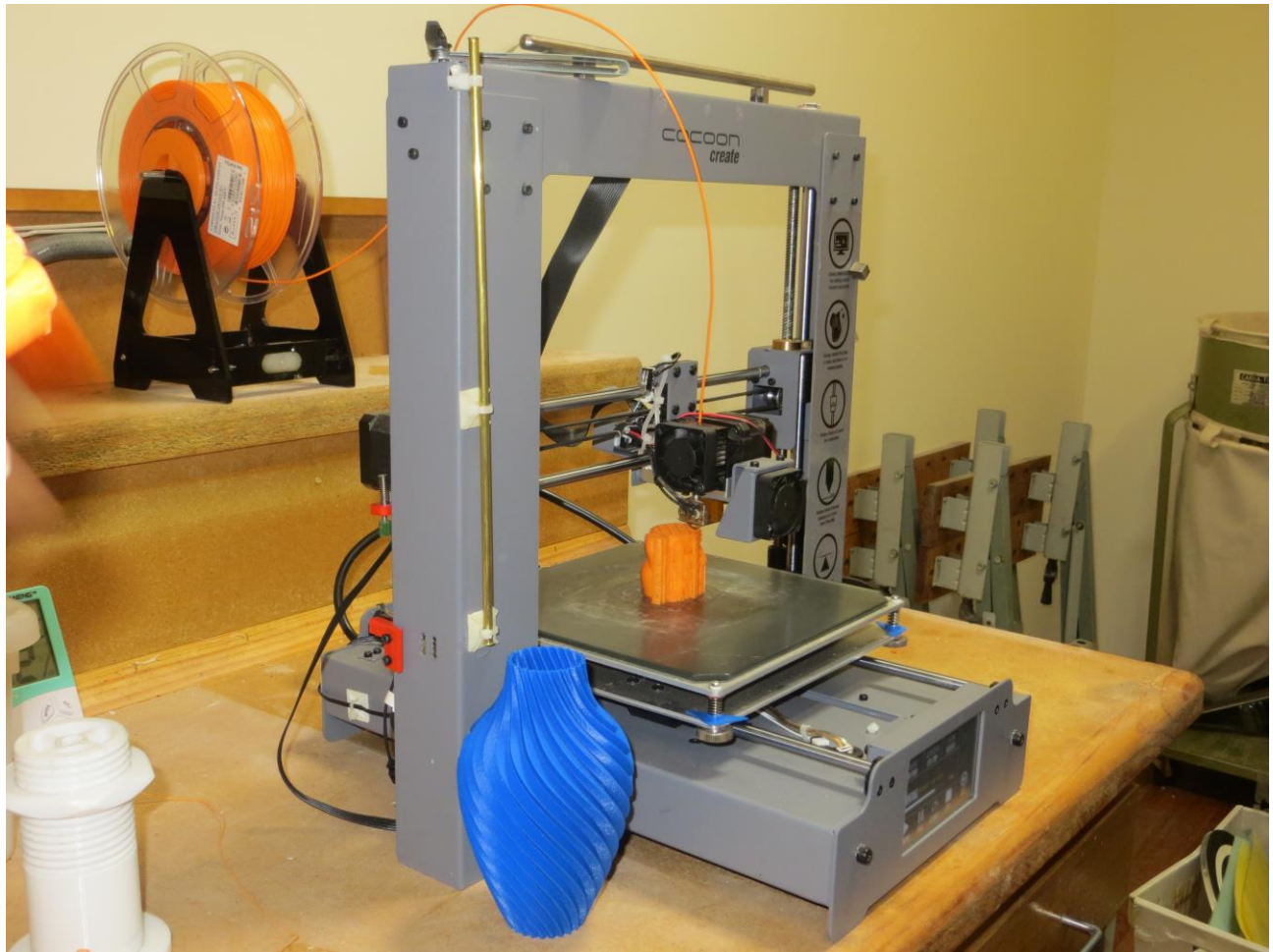
3D Printing by David Taylor

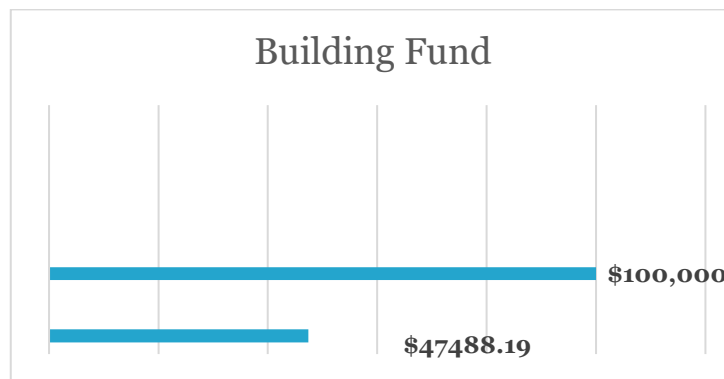
