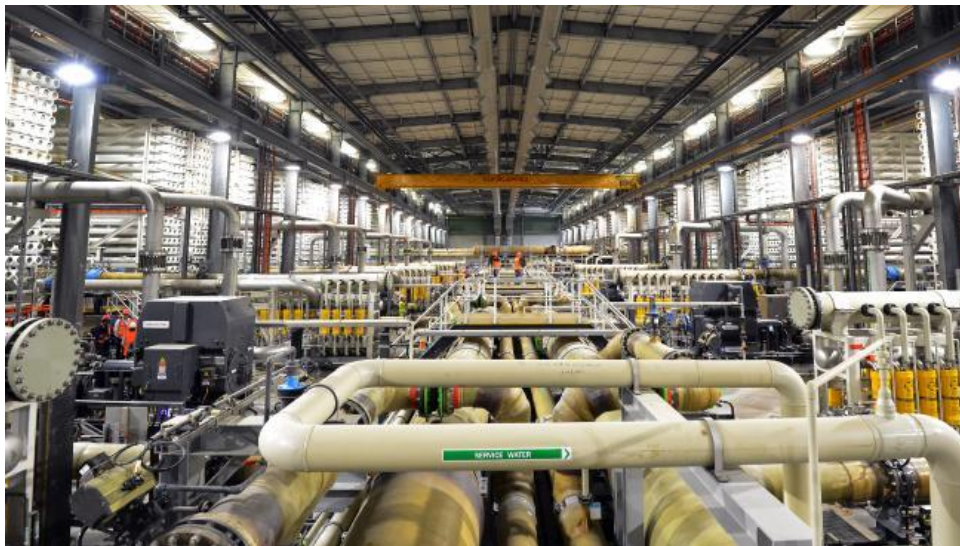

As usual there was the extremely busy period when participants arrived from 11 am to provide their details to the registration desk. As they moved to the next desk they were given a Bendigo Bank bag containing promotional material from sponsors as well as bottled water, a fresh apple plus a golf ball and tees. Hans Van Dyk manned this desk with capable assistance from his 6 year old granddaughter. The next desk was surrounded by golfers purchasing tickets to our raffle hoping to win the 55 inch TV or apple iPad Pro or some of the other 5 prizes. The 2 ticket sellers could not cope with ticket sales but we were fortunate that Men's Shed member Graham Seymour arrived early for his 'ball spotting' task and his valuable assistance saved the day. 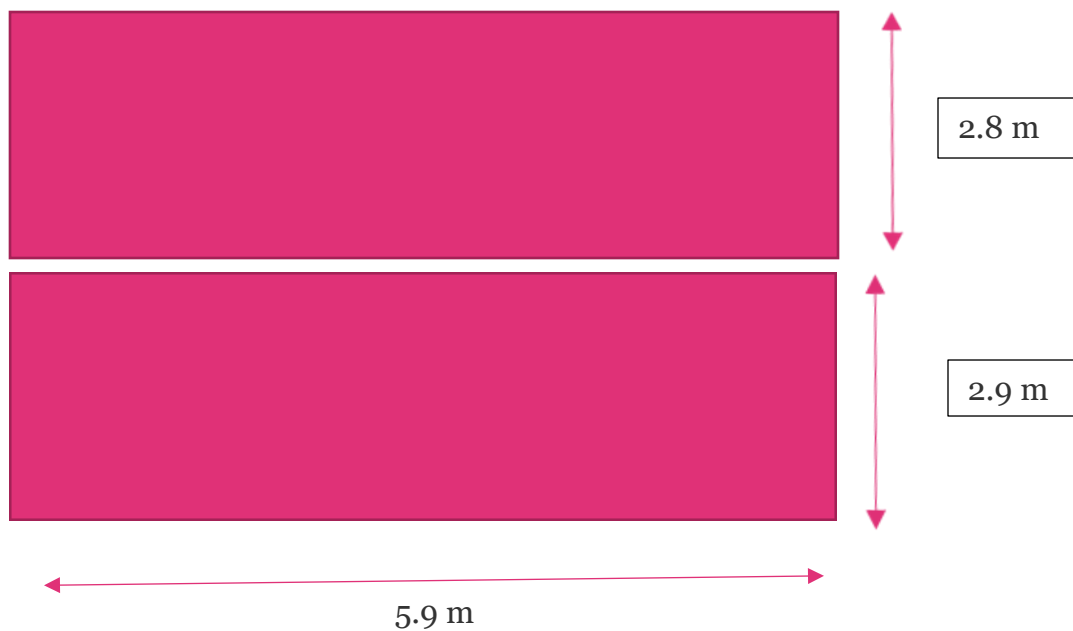

## **Parks Victoria (PV)**

Negotiations continue with PV and they are currently working through the options and requirements for a site at Lysterfield Park. President Trevor has suggested a planning scheme amendment to PV which will enable a Men's Shed to be on PV Land. A meeting between PV and City of Casey to be held re the planning scheme amendment.

## **City of Casey**

A cost estimate has been received from the City of Casey to enclose the area under the verandah. The estimate is \$67000, council suggest that we apply for a \$50,000 grant which will have to contribute 20% that is \$10,000 and negotiate the remaining \$17,000 with council. Hence it could cost us up to \$27000 to have the area enclosed. This will be discussed at Tuesday's meeting.

A copy of the draft lease has now been received from the City of Casey, the cost of the lease is proposed at \$150 per year plus 40% of outgoings. This will be discussed at the meeting on Tuesday.

These would then be mounted on a sheet to hang or on an A frame.

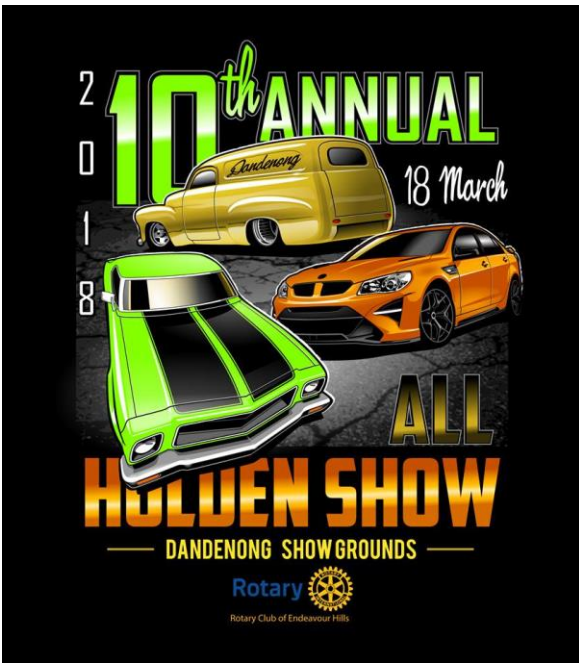

## Dandenong All Holden Car Show on 18<sup>th</sup> March 2018

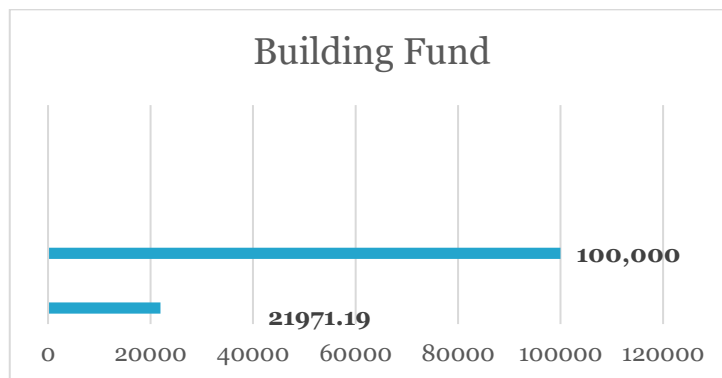
