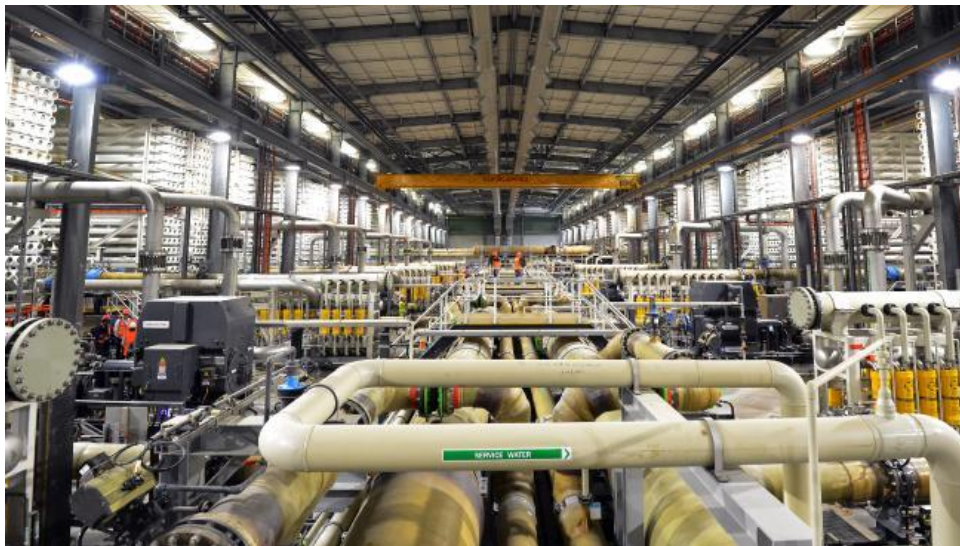

Last week's meeting

- It was unanimously resolved that the EHMS does not apply for a grant to enclose the verandah area.
- It was unanimously resolved to accept the proposed lease and licence in principle and to instruct the Committee to negotiate suitable terms with the City of Casey.
- A report was given to the meeting on the heads of sheds meeting at Nyora.
- Friday 16th March is the Bunnings BBQ Day followed by the Car Show on 18th March
- The loan of equipment to members, this was referred to the committee of management to form a policy.



On 4th March a group of members went to the sporting shooters association for rifle practice. President Trevor proudly brought in his target sheet which has according to my calculations had a score of 360. The cost was \$25 per person discounted from the normal price of \$45. This is the second visit by the EHMS and a further practice session is scheduled for September. Why did Doug not have his target sheet in the photograph.

EHMS Committee Meeting

On Friday a Committee Meeting was held primarily to discuss the terms and conditions of the proposed lease and license for the Essex Park Drive, a schedule of questions is being prepared for submission to the City Casey.

Other matters discussed were:

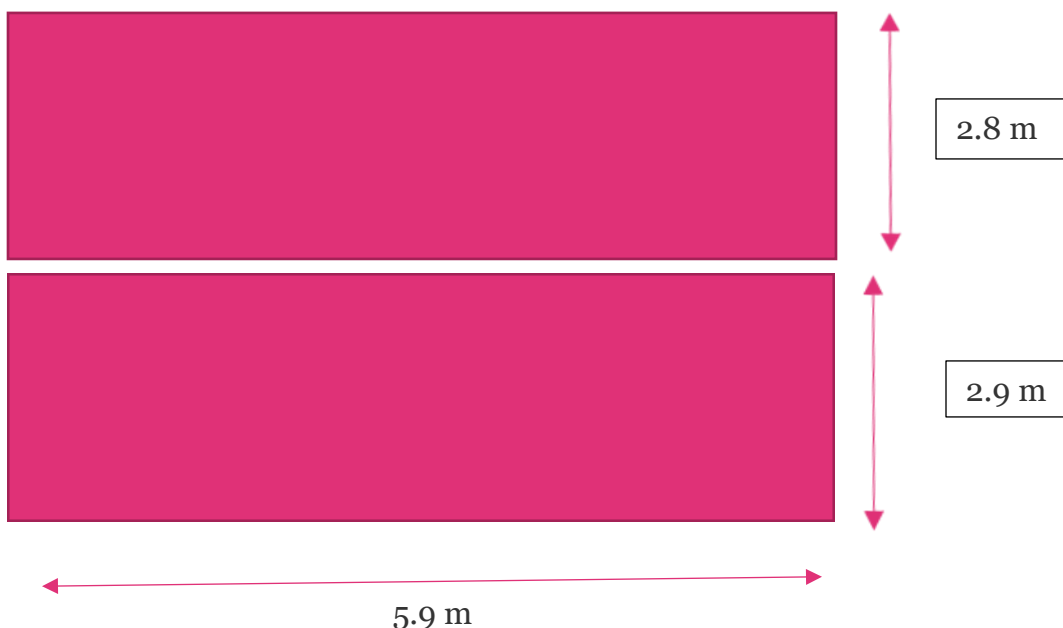
- Policy regarding lending of EHMS equipment to members for their private use. It was resolved that nothing leaves the premise for private use. It was resolved that this policy may be reconsidered as determined by the committee.
- It was resolved to accept the tendered resignation of Treasurer Tony Phillips. The position of treasure is now vacant. The secretary is acting treasurer until a replacement is determined.
- There was detailed discussion about operational matters for the EHMS BBQ at the Rotary Club of Endeavor Hills All Holden Car Show.

New Endeavour Hills Probus Club

This new club has been formed and the first meeting is on 19th March 2018 10.00 am at the Dandenong Club. This new Probus Club is sponsored by the Rotary Club of Endeavour Hills and the Inaugural President is Martin Pater, a member of the RCEH and a friend of EHMS.

EHMS New workshop area

The proposal from council is that the EHMS lease the existing storeroom and adjacent area behind the inside roller door for use as a workshop and a licence over the remainder of the centre for 3 days a week. The lease will be for 3 years with a payment of \$150.00 per year to council.

Parks Victoria (PV)

Negotiations continue with PV and they are currently working through the options and requirements for a site at Lysterfield Park. President Trevor has suggested a planning scheme amendment to PV which will enable a Men's Shed to be on PV Land. A meeting between PV and City of Casey to be held re the planning scheme amendment. PV is also working with the City of Casey to form a Committee of Management for the Sydney Parteger Reserve.

City of Casey

Due to the ridiculously inflated cost the members voted unanimously against applying for a grant of \$50,000 which would have cost the EHMS \$17,000+

A copy of the draft lease has now been received from the City of Casey, the cost of the lease is proposed at \$150 per year plus 40% of outgoings. This will be discussed at the meeting on Tuesday.

Other activities

Car Boot Sale – Hans van Dyke is talking to Endeavour Hills Shopping Centre Management re holding a car boot sale at the shopping centre as a fundraiser for the EHMS.

Letter size is 150mm for caps and 100mm for rest.

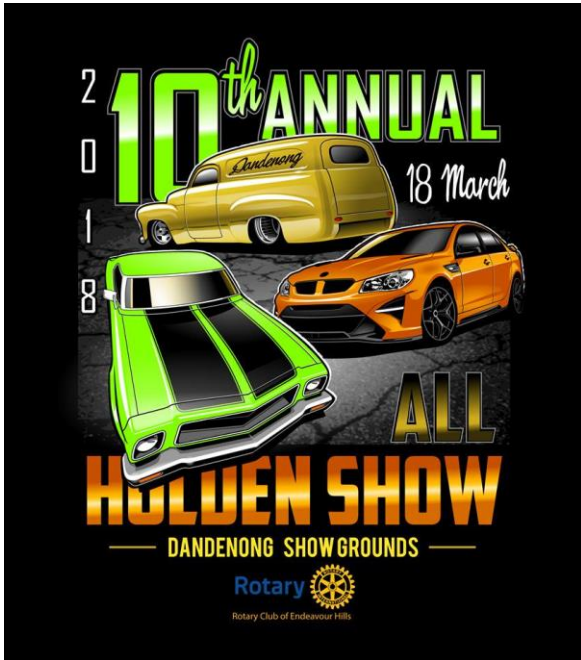
These would then be mounted on a sheet to hang or on an A frame.

Dandenong All Holden Car Show on 18th March 2018

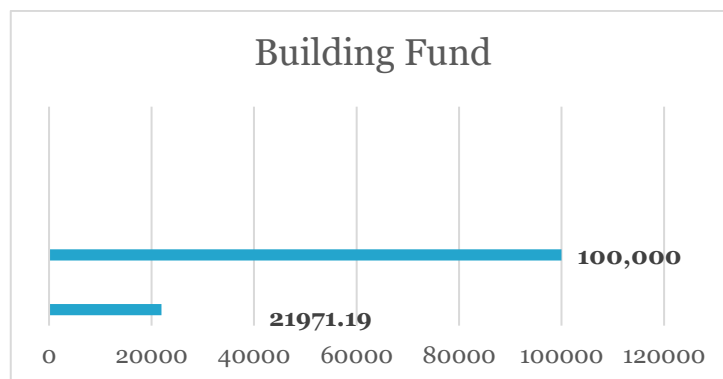
