Permanent Shed



The City of Casey has now allocated a site to the Endeavour Hills Men's Shed on the Sydney Pargeter Reserve. The picture above shows the site. The Committee attended a meeting with council officers on Wednesday when we were asked to raise up to \$1,000,000.00. Council will then build a "shed" on the land.

The process from here is:

- Casey Council Officers report to Council
- Formal agreement with Parks Victoria
- Letter of support from council
- Confirmation of Funding
- Lease

The building is to be to a standard suitable for use as a public building. Hence the very high cost'

A further on-site meeting will take place on 9th April to discuss in some detail the reasons for the high cost.

Following the meeting council has agreed to prepare an "Opinion on Probable Cost"

The Sydney Pargeter Reserve is filled land and soil tests will be necessary to determine any necessary piling which will add to the cost of the building.

In response to an email from VP Doug Angie from the City of Casey said:

"Thanks for your email. I can confirm that there is no kennel/dog club currently allocated a parcel of land at Sydney Pargeter Reserve. There was a group similar to this, but they have moved on approximately 3-5 years ago"

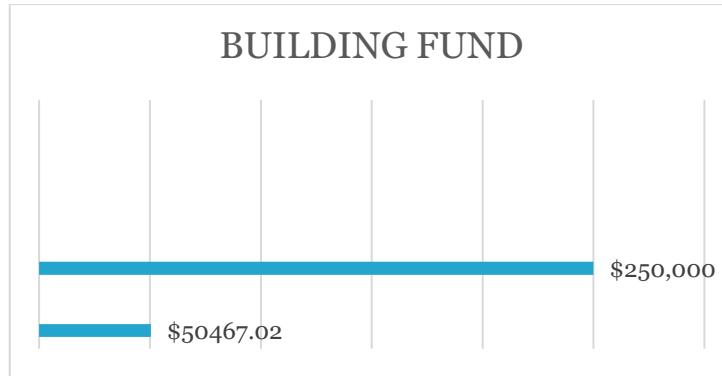
