



Victorian Government Grants for Men's Sheds.

Expressions of Interest for this year's grants are now open. The maximum grant available is \$80.000.00 provided that the shed can add \$40.000.00 from their own funds.

We will apply for this grant, meaning that, given the latest council estimate, we need to raise a further \$820,000.00 from other sources.

President Trevor has successfully provided an expression of Interest which has been accepted by the State Government and application forms will be sent out on 7th May closing 23rd July.
