Extract from Neil Evans's family history to fill in the gap raised in his life story talk this morning.

"David Evans Jnr (four-times-great-grandfather) was born in Llandilo Merionethshire Wales.

When David was 20 years of age, he joined the Merionethshire Militia where he was a Private during the Napoleonic War fighting for the English against the French.

As this war was mainly fought on the beaches of the southernmost tip of Britain, (namely Cornwall), the majority of soldiers settled in the local area after the war rather than returning to their original homes."


