A meeting with council officers/councilors with the Committee was held on Wednesday 28th August 2019, both the Mayor, Councillor Stapleton and Deputy Mayor, Councillor Crestani attended. This was a very positive meeting. Subject to the State Government (DHS) grant being awarded for \$80,000, tenders will be called for and a contract awarded before Christmas. Work will start in January and be completed by the end of June. A full report will be given this week.

President Trevor has submitted our application for a State Government Grant for up to \$80,000. It took several emails to get all our information submitted. We now must wait until later in the year to see if we are successful.


