A meeting with council officers/councillors with the Committee was held on Wednesday 28th August 2019, both the Mayor, Councillor Stapleton and Deputy Mayor, Councillor Crestani attended. This was a very positive meeting. Subject to the State Government (DHS) grant being awarded for \$80,000, tenders will be called for and a contract awarded before Christmas. Work will start in January and be completed by the end of June. A full report will be given this week.

President Trevor has submitted our application for a State Government Grant for up to \$80,000. It took several emails to get all our information submitted. We now must wait until later in the year to see if we are successful.

Please all shedders put your thinking caps on, we will need to continue fundraising after our permanent shed is built to cover outgoings for the new build. 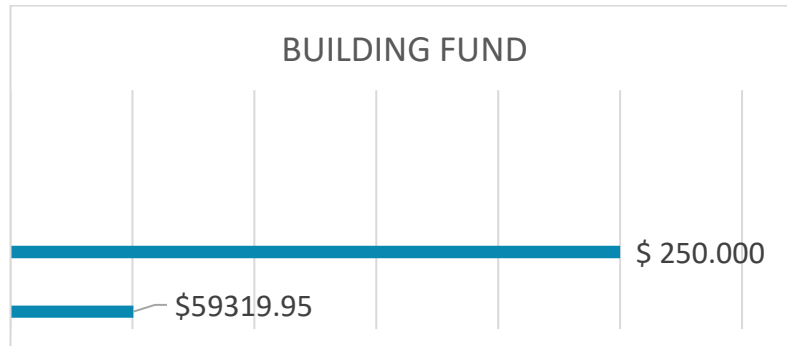
