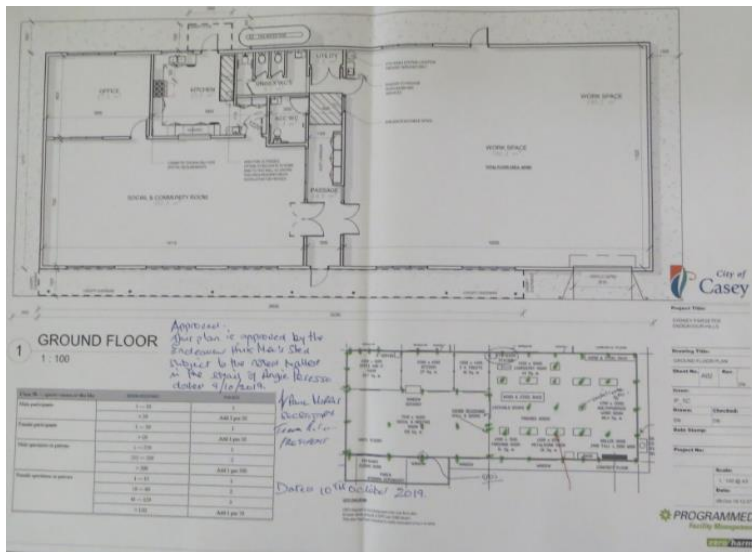

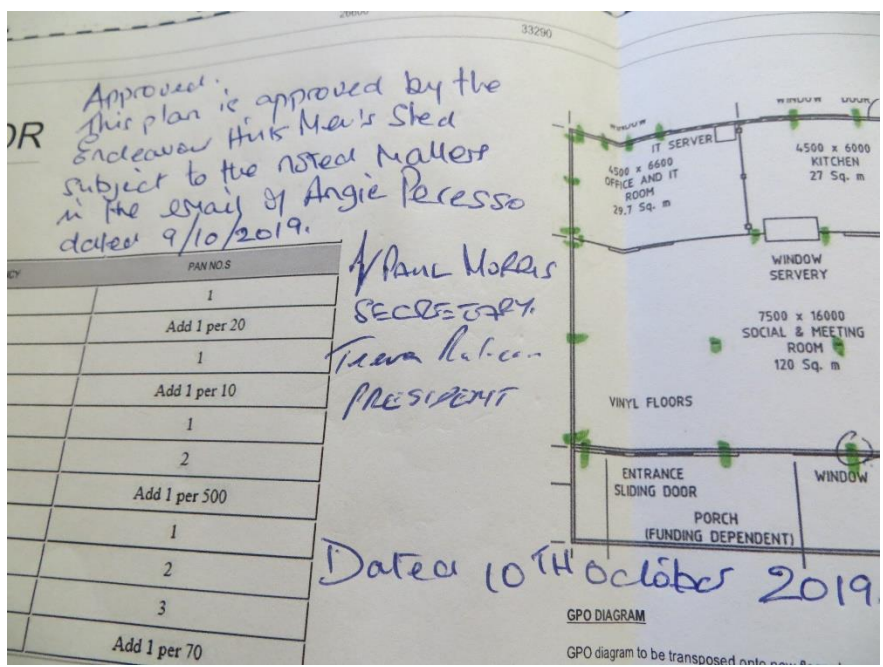
Sign off on the Shed design

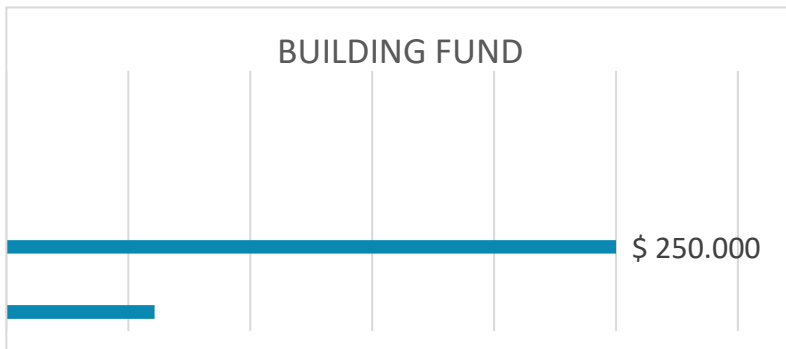
