The Hon. Luke Donnellan invited us to a photo opportunity on the site of the new Endeavour Hills Men's Shed. We have been granted \$80,000 by the State Government's Men's Shed Grants.

The Endeavour Hills Men's Shed has gone form Incorporation on 20th March 2017 to having a permanent site with funds and approvals, ready to start work in January 2020, in less than 3 years.

Work will start in January and be completed by the end of June.

Tenders close 11th December and once the pricing is known we may have to negotiate with council before the tender is awarded.

Please all shedders put your thinking caps on, we will need to continue fundraising after our permanent shed is built to cover outgoings for the new build If you have an idea please follow it through **yourself before** presenting it at a meeting. Trevor is working very hard behind the scenes but cannot do it alone nor should he, we all want a shed so let's all help.


Building Fund

Before the successful tenderer is awarded the tender, we will have to pay our share of the building costs to the City of Casey (\$40,000).
