Permanent Shed



We await the selection of the site at Sydney Pargeter reserve. Council are currently liaising with other organisations before allocating a site. We have the support of the Mayor and Councillor Crestani from the City of Casey.

We have been advised to expect an email from council early this week.

The process from here is:

- Casey Council Officers report to Council
- Formal agreement with Parks Victoria
- Letter of support from council
- EHMS responsible plans and approvals
- Confirmation of Funding
- Lease

The Sydney Pargeter Reserve is filled land and soil tests will be necessary to determine any necessary piling which will add to the cost of the building.

We have now increased our funding target to \$250,000.00 with the final target to be determined.

The time frame for this year's round of grants is, given the above, extremely tight.

Council will expect us to provide

- Confirmation of project funding
- Building Plans and documentation reviewed and approved by Council's Building Design and Construction, Building Management Services and Park Services Departments
- Approved Planning permit obtained
- Approved Building permit obtained
- A Memorandum of Understanding created between Council and Endeavour Hills Men's Shed.

A great visit to the Abloy Factory, our guide was Michael Cachia was obviously very proud of his set up and his is working on continuous improvement.


A lot of work is being won back from China using new equipment and robots. Thanks, Howard, for organizing this unusual visit. It was good to see you meet old colleagues again.


