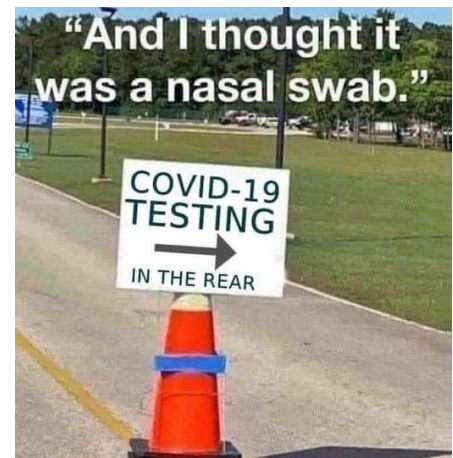
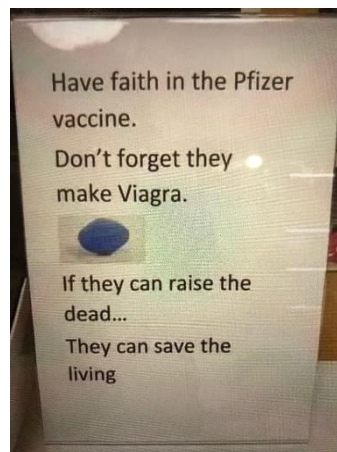

Resetting AED Cabinet Alarm

1. Alarm will operate once AED Cabinet door is opened and will latch until reset.
2. Remove Alarm Unit from Holder and locate Toggle Switch
3. Operate Toggle switch in both directions, Alarm Tone should change pitch.
4. Close the AED Cabinet Door and Alarm should cease sounding

The Defibrillator cabinet is now armed and ready.
