



SIMPLIFIED TARGET SCORING



- Shots in or touching the bullseye count as 10
- Shots in the smaller centre ring count as 11 in case of a tie.
- Shots in the nine ring count as 9 (unless touching the 10 ring), and so on.
- My woeful 2019 score of 476/500 was made up of 28x10's, 20x 9's and 2x8's.

(The above is based on the 50 metre rimfire target used by SSAV to assess eligibility to cull feral animals in the Farmer Assist Program.)

I use this at 120 metres to sight in my personal rifle, periodically checking deviation between different ammo's, then always purchase the brand and velocity which performs best in my rifle. Laurie C.

Remember members must be trained to the satisfaction of the trainer on each tool before they can use it. A list of tools and trainers is given below.


