

Ukraine Refugee Crisis

A quick summary of what is happening with the Ukraine

- We have been running an Appeal and as a result we have sent 3 SkyHydrants + \$10,000 to Disaster Aid Europe (DAE). (We are planning to send more funds that have been donated and another 2 SkyHydrants requested by DAE)
- Dianne Holland and myself have also been providing advice and support to DA Europe.
- DAE has been travelling to the Ukraine border with supplies which include SkyHydrants (from us) and aid materials which have been handed over.
- Disaster Aid UK have sent two DARTS to Romania who have arranged for a generator to be shipped to a Ukraine Hospital and are currently looking at sourcing more generators.
- Disaster Aid USA has sent a large consignment of Sawyer water filters and other aid materials to DAE
- DAUSA in combination with RC of Warszawa city have paid for a second-hand ambulance which has been serviced and sent to the Ukraine.
- DA Canada has raised \$10,000 for Sawyer water filters.
- A Sawyer Filter Instructional Video was also made and uploaded to YouTube to support the Sawyer Filters being sent by DA USA for Ukraine. To watch click on this link: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Mfhmfkoc6Ag
