
Rotary Car Show

Covid 19

Top ten tips to prepare ahead

- Get the next dose of your COVID-19 vaccine as soon as you are eligible. Book today
- 2. Always have basic medical supplies like a thermometer, pain relief and your regular medications available
- Make sure you have enough face masks, hand sanitiser and gloves if you have to isolate
- 4. Plan ahead for who can safely deliver supplies if you have to isolate
- 5. Plan ahead for home activities to keep you entertained if you have to isolate
- 6. Plan ahead for who can look after children or pets if you have to go to hospital
- 7. Check for symptoms regularly and get tested as soon as they develop
- 8. Have Rapid antigen tests in your house and know your COVID checklists in advance
- 9. Keep your home well ventilated (windows open) and have gatherings outdoors
- 10. Have an emergency contact list with important phone numbers including your GP



DISASTER AID AUSTRALIA AID ACTIVITIES

Typhoon Odette, Dinagat Island, Philipinnes

- We dispatched a further 3 SkyHydrants, supported by Rotarian DG Augie Soliman of Manila.
- Made a \$5,000 grant to Balay Mindanaw for the purchase of materials for home repair and rebuilding.

Bhutan

- A SkyHydrant has been installed at Gyalpozhing College.
- Currently we have 7 SkyHydrants ready to ship as soon as flights become available.

East Timor

• 4 SkyHydrant MAXs delivered to DIK at Footscray to be shipped to Timor Leste for Max Bird's project.

PARTNERSHIPS

- Disaster Aid International will have a stand at the RI Houston Convention
- Balay Mindanaw notified us that they had been asked help clear 3 GEM SkyHydrants shipped to the Philippines by ASB (a German aid charity) for ACCORD a charity in the Philippines. We have subsequently contacted ASB who have expressed an interest in working together with us and SkyJuice.
- Discussions with Rhett Butler about DAA supplying SkyJuice with our GEM Rapid Response Packs.
- The 'Roundtrip Foundation' have expressed an interest in partnering on delivery of SkyHydrants.
- We have been assisting a Sydney Rotary Cluster with transport options for sending 2 SkyHydrants to Nepal.
- Potential partnership with Fiji rotarians has been identified thanks to Angeline Low.
- Discussions with Damage Control Project management (DCPM) who have expressed an interest in supporting our activities
