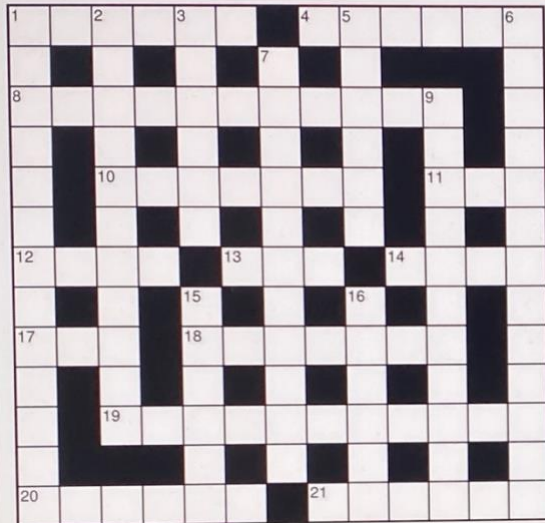

## **Talking Point For Members**

The September meeting of EHMS Committee agreed to discuss in detail a proposed (by myself, Ron Sterling) Policy and Program which would set in place the period a member could hold the position of President and perhaps other senior positions in our shed.

The proposal is that the tenure of the position be for 1 year with a second year if elected at the subsequent AGM. After a maximum of two years the position to be filled by vote at the AGM and the outgoing president would hold the non elected position of Immediate Past President.

### **Why?**

Men's Sheds are self governing, making their own decisions and shaping the shed's activities to meet the local membership. They don't have any controlling body above them to impose or guide decision making.

This is a great responsibility and perhaps general members are reluctant to take on these senior positions because of the responsibility involved and the time necessary to fulfil this role.

If the tenure is limited to a maximum of two years then members may consider standing for this shorter period. Many sheds have secretaries, treasurers and presidents who have given considerable years of service to their sheds.

A good stepping up position would be Vice President to President and maybe nominating from within the committee, assistant secretary, treasurer.

Certainly by spreading the load over shorter periods we can benefit from new ideas and attract members who would not be able to give the long term ongoing support we have received from our present executive.

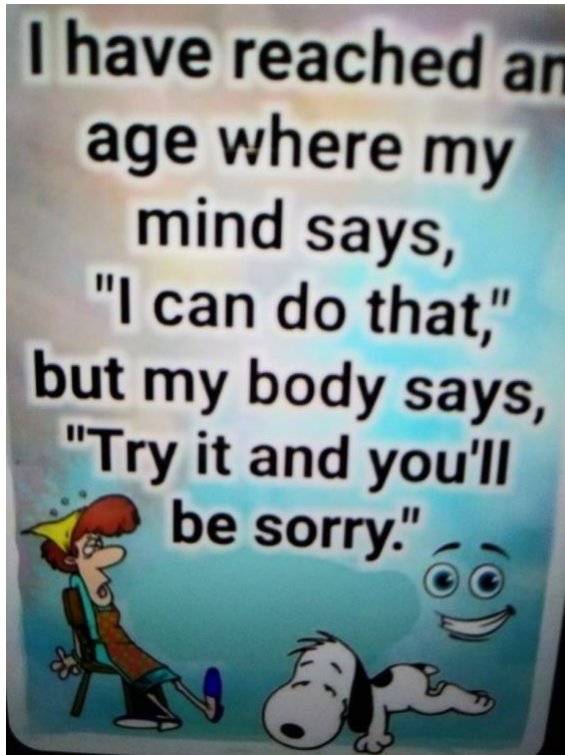
As this proposal is for a policy only .it would be able to be implemented without changing our existing rules which are recorded with the relevant Victorian government bodies for not for profit organisations (CAV).

Please think about this and if interested talk to the executive or the general committee. There is a draft (not yet endorsed) policy and program which can be provided if you would like to read in detail.

The policy will be before the committee at its next meeting which is scheduled for Wednesday 16th October.
