Derek conducted an exercise session.

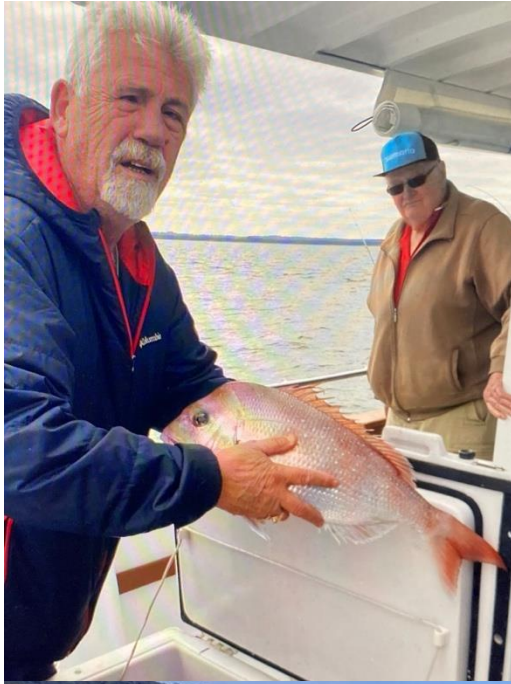
Stan, Graeme, Bruno and team provided a tasty BBQ lunch.
