> Old Blokes.


















Here we have Peter (who only arrived for the first time this morning) blacking the tyres.





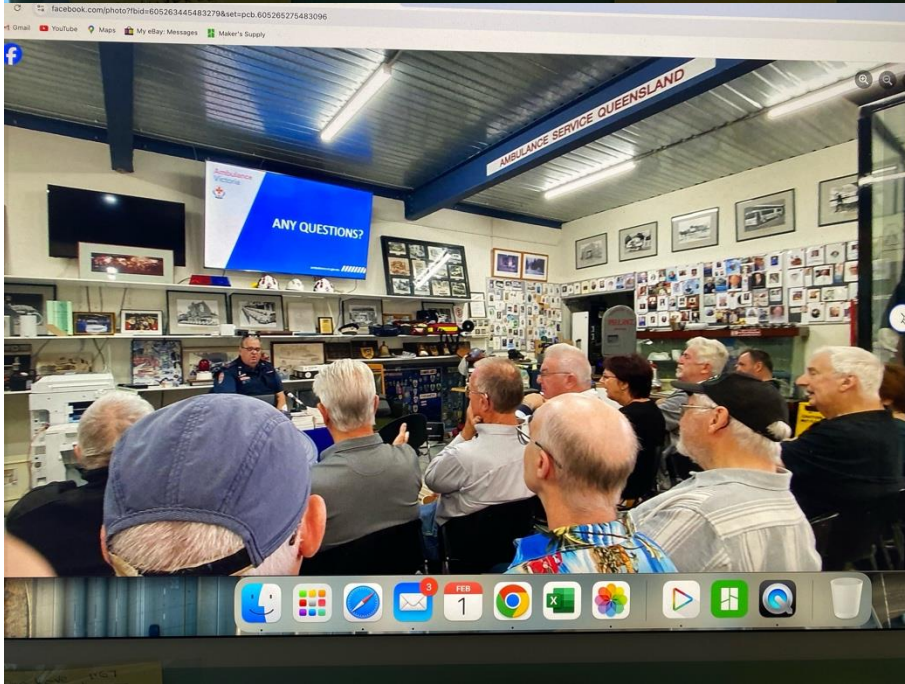
And then we had the visit to the Ambulance Museum in Bayswater. I'm sure they all enjoyed a meal and get together after, but nobody took any photos.



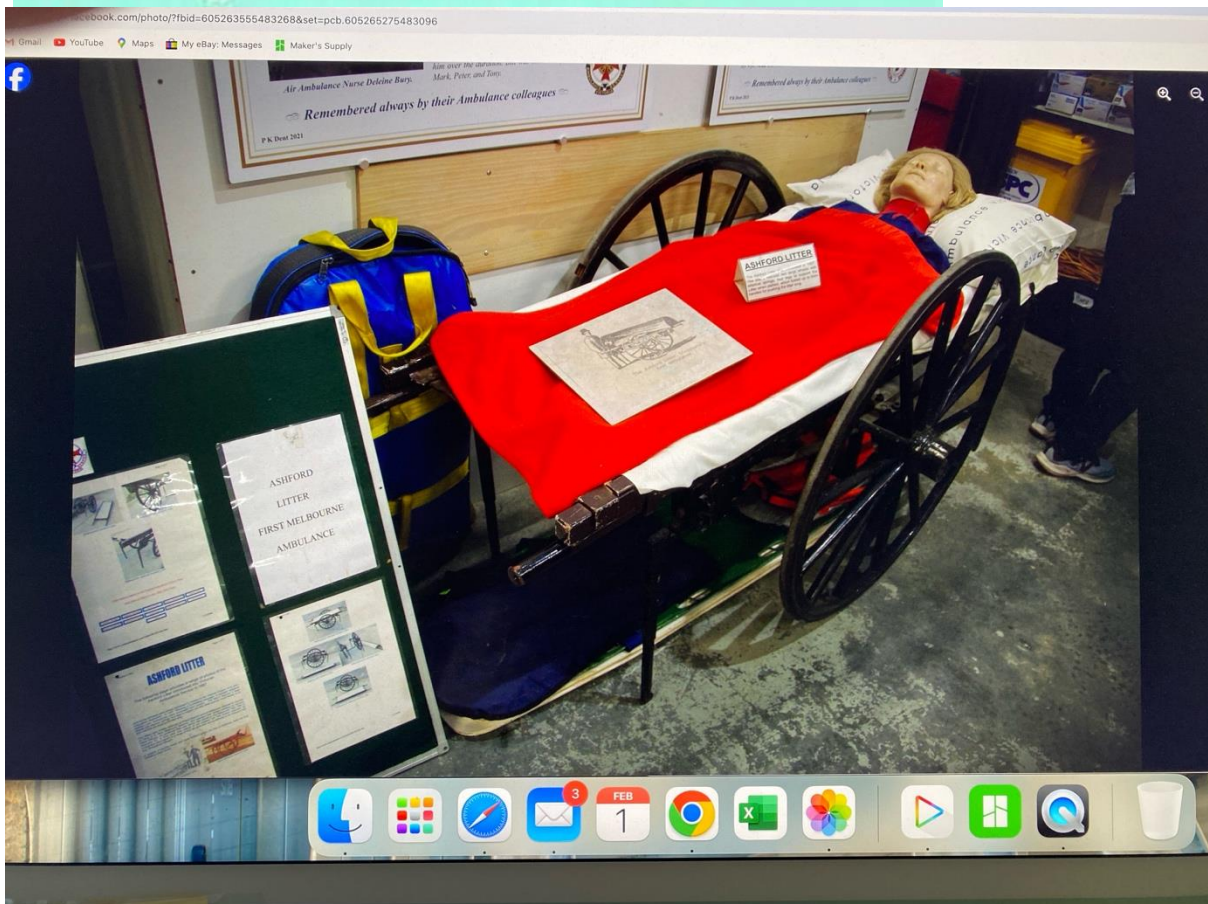
Here we have Ross, Bob and Will.
