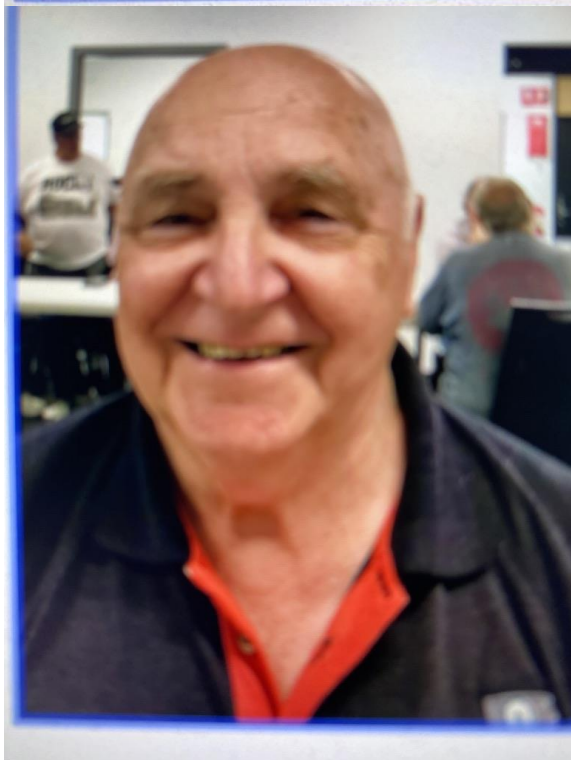
Rafael Peralta learned of the passing of his brother in Argentina this week and we all support him at this time, especially with the distance involved which makes contact with loved ones difficult.

It appears that an animal microchip registry, [HomesafeID](#), has ceased operation, and has now been de-listed by the Victorian government as a microchip registry.

If your cat or dog is registered with [HomesafeID](#), you are strongly advised to register your pet with one of the other microchip registries. [HomesafeID](#) has apparently been uncontactable since December 2024, however their website ([www.homesafeid.com](http://www.homesafeid.com)) is still operating at the moment but may go dark in the near future. If that happens, your pet's microchip information will no longer be available online meaning it will be difficult to reunite you with your pet should it become lost.

The [HomesafeID](#) website has the following notice on it

**“12 Feb 2025:** Under the terms of the [Domestic Animals Act](#), **Agriculture Victoria** has formally requested a copy of all Victorian records and are working to identify another registry to take over the records, and that will be on their [website](#) in due course.”

Please ensure your pets are microchipped, and they are registered with a microchip registry other than [HomesafeID](#).

"That sure is a nice fire truck," the firefighter said with admiration.

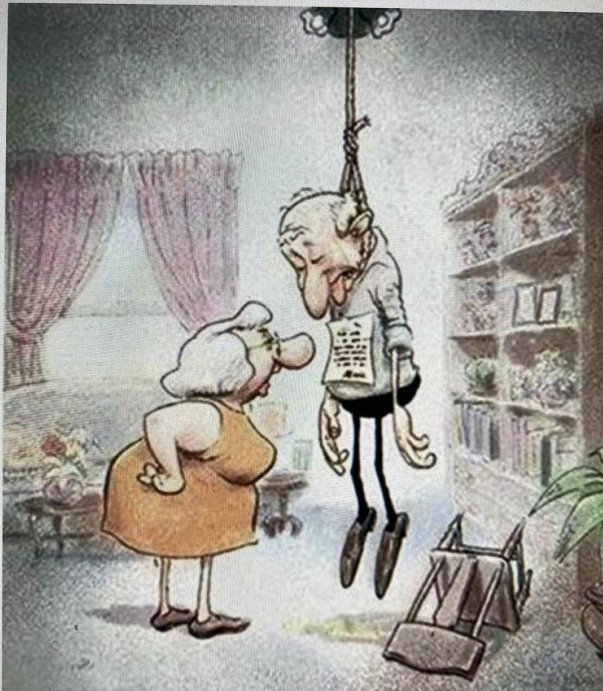
"Thanks," the girl replied.

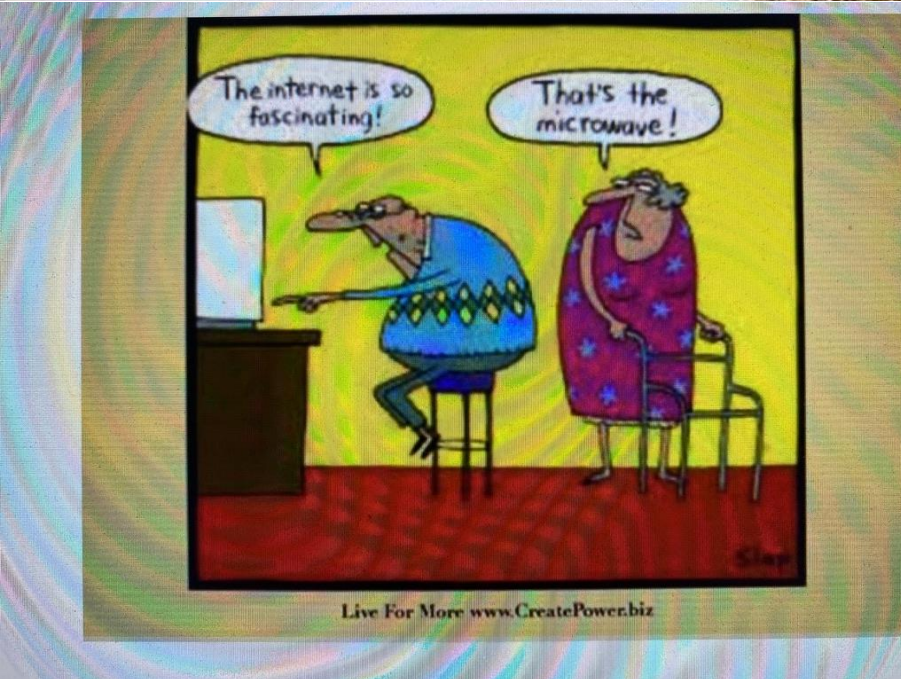

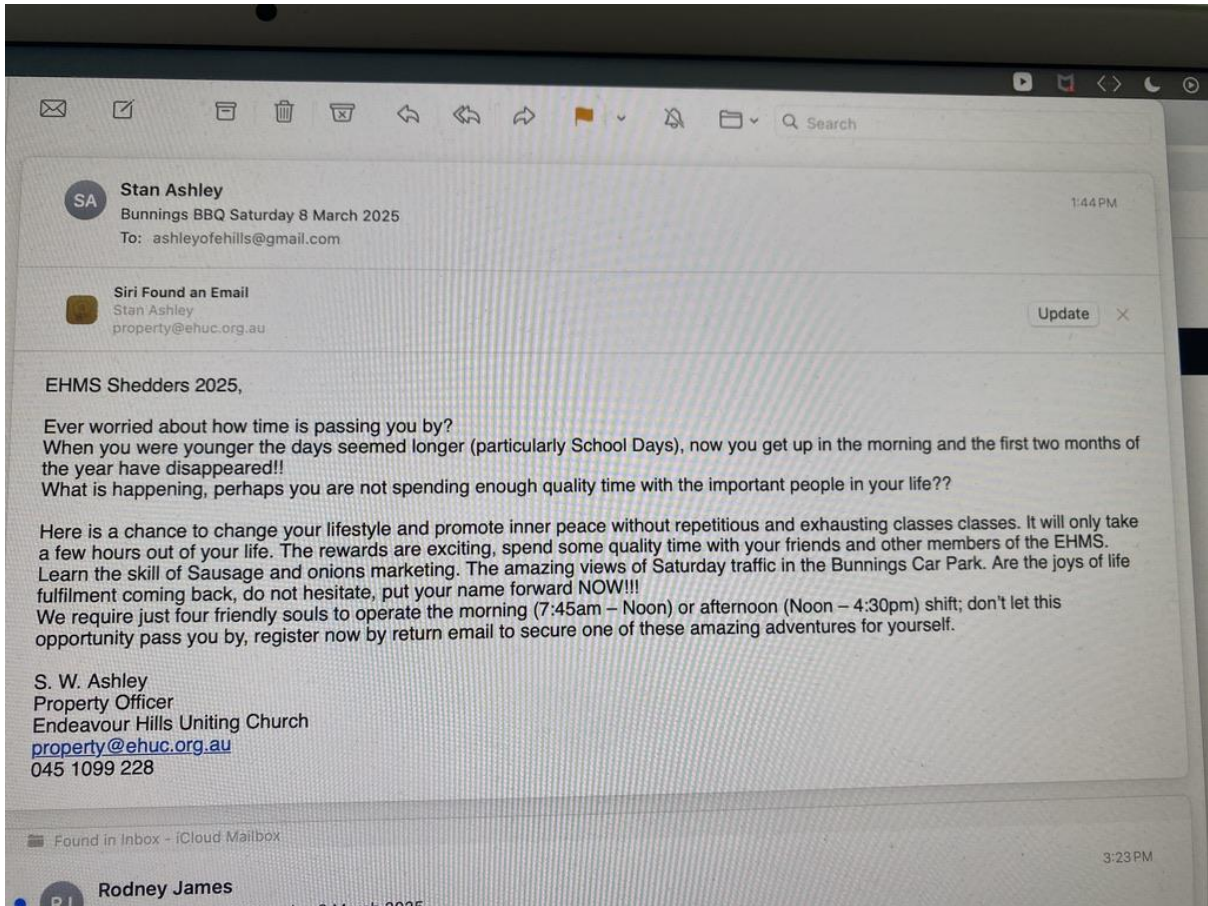
