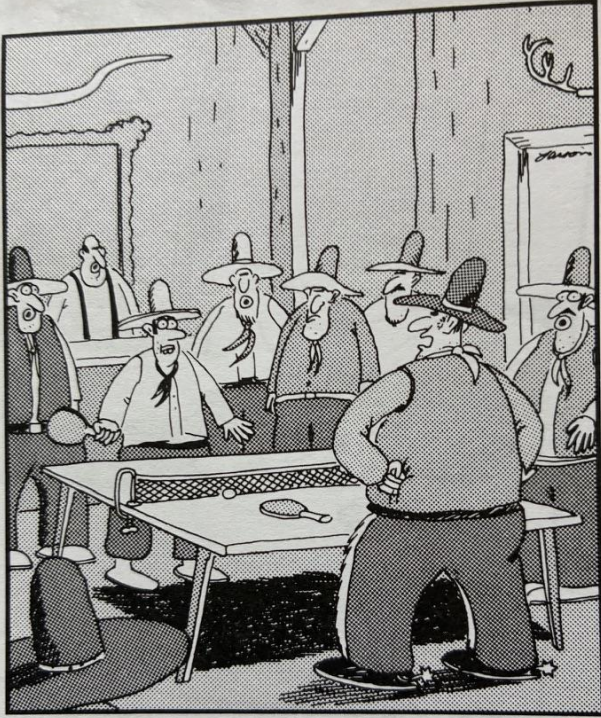
A young priest arrives in his new parish and he's only 6 days there when his bicycle is stolen. This makes him very annoyed, and he complains bitterly to the Parish priest.

So, he's waiting for him Sunday after the mass and asks him if he did the 10 commandments and when he got to Thou shall not steal, did he find his bicycle?

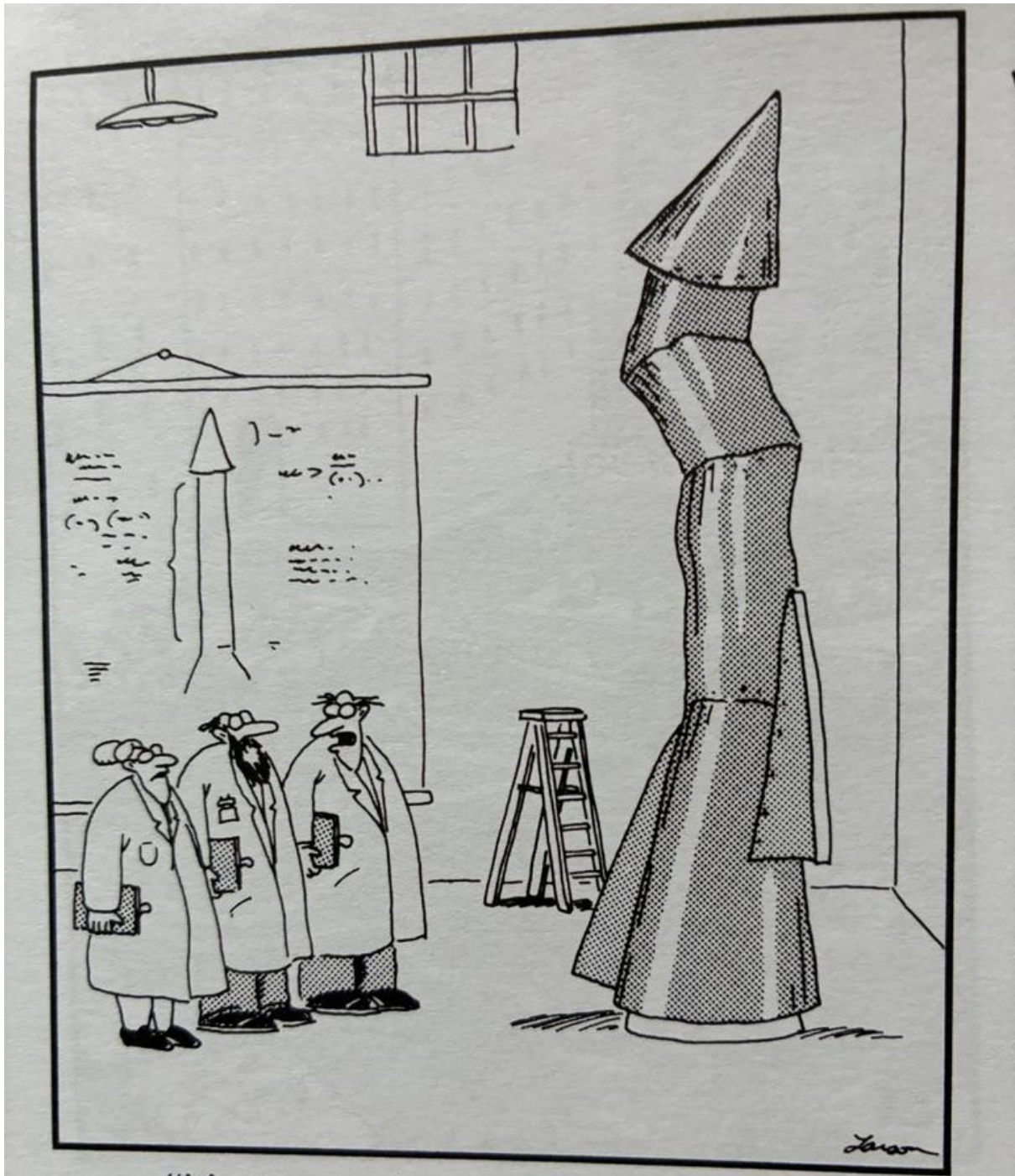

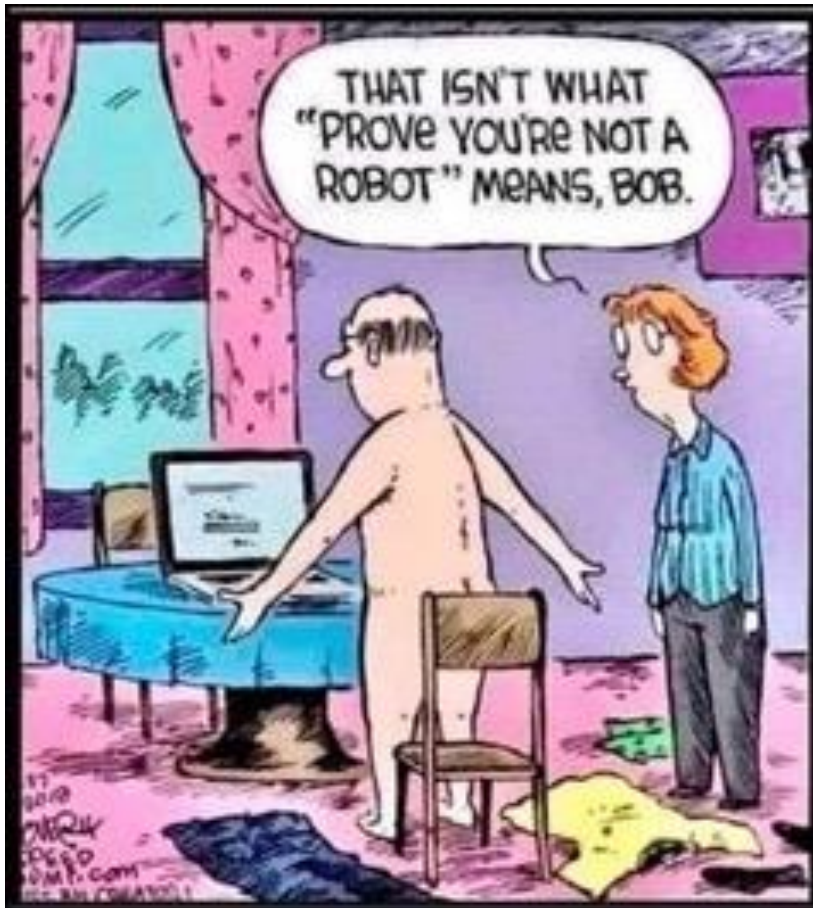

The dentist then asks the patient if he has any objection to taking a pill

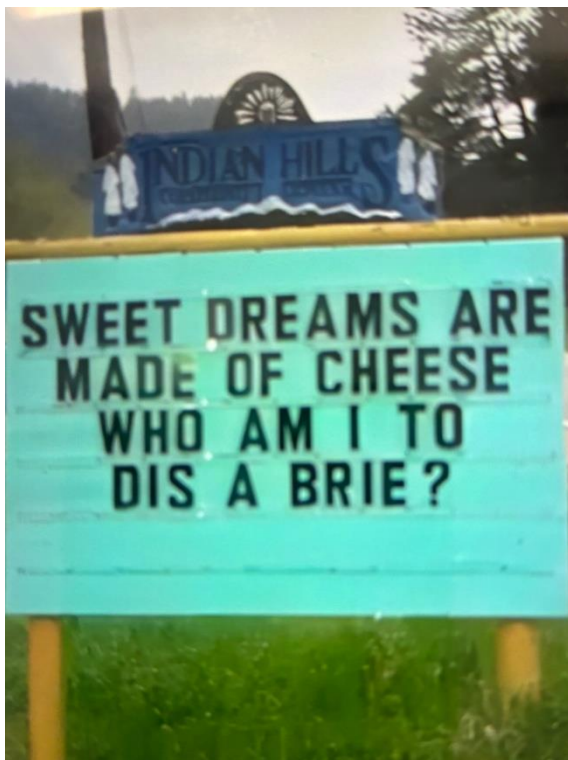
“No objection at all, “the patient says.
