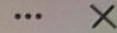

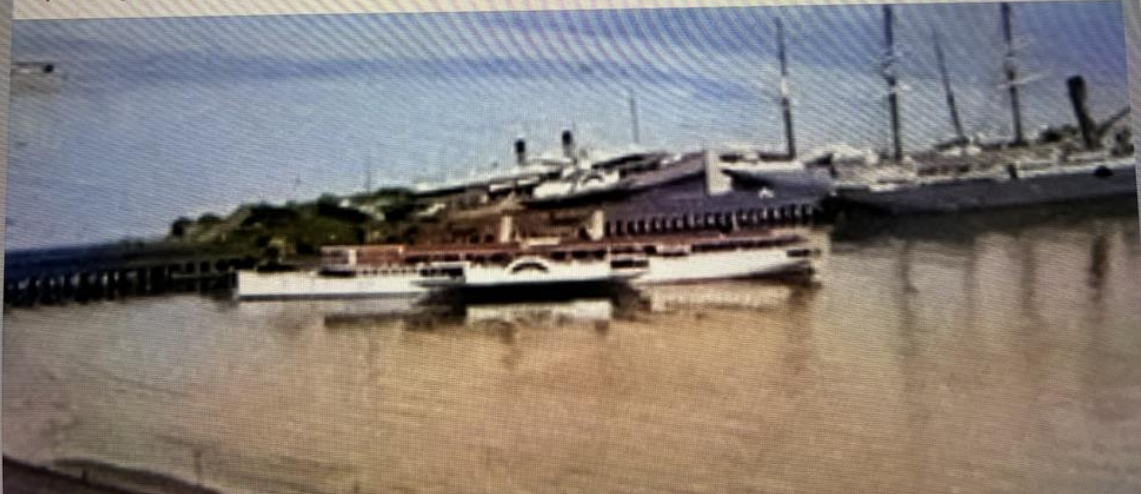

The Ozone was a pleasure cruiser that operated in the late 19th and early 20th century in Port Phillip Bay, Victoria. It specialized in day cruises around the Bay. "Bravo Murphy lad, and the second one?" asks the doctor.

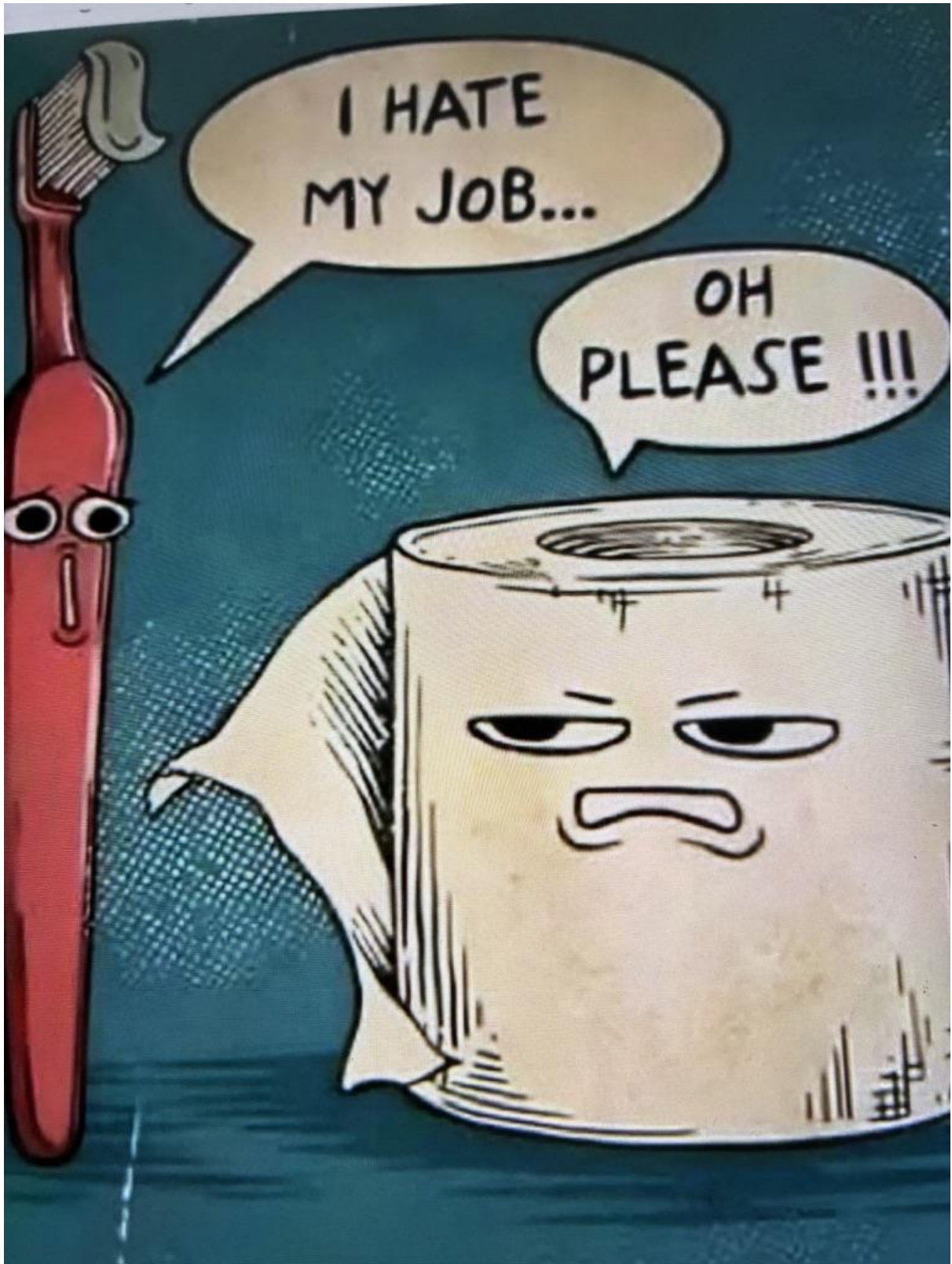
"The second one had indigestion and I gave him Gaviscon, so I did sir" says Murphy.

"I put drops in her eyes."




Paddy and Murphy swap sandwiches at work.

Paddy answers, "Crab Paste"

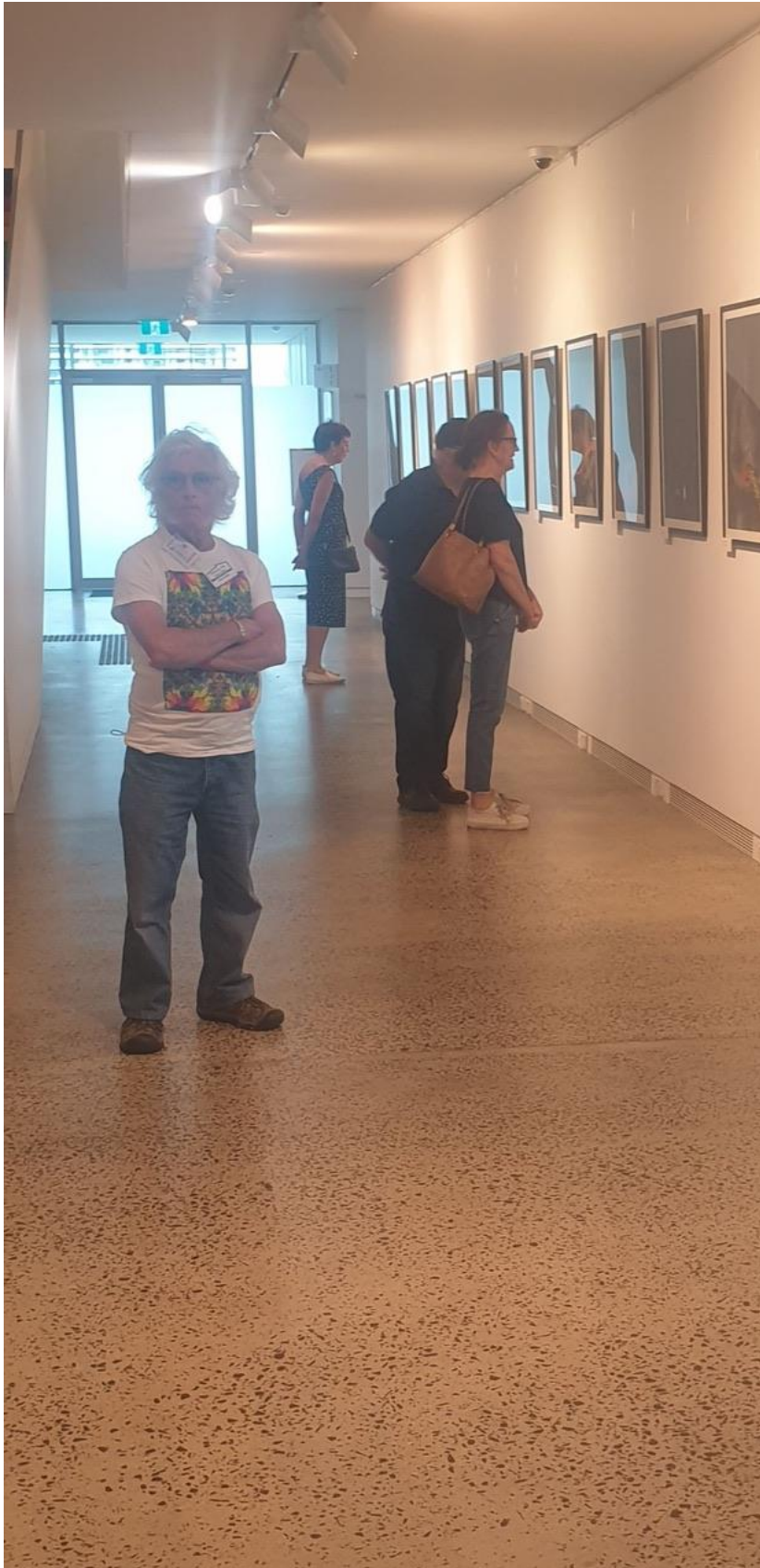

And that was before they had to add the Electro-magnets that made the electron beam flat and the next part that make the particle beam turn corners

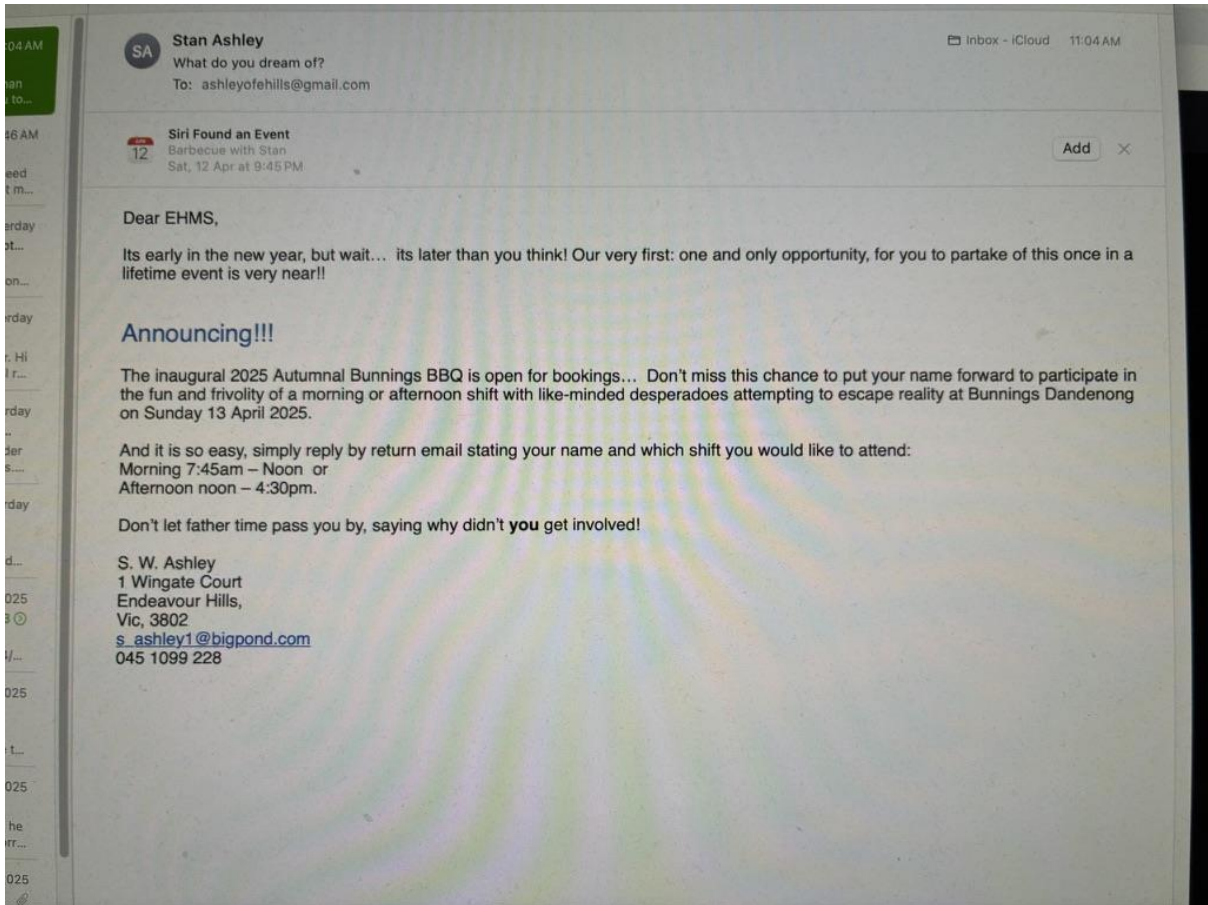
Mate - I'm sure you would be as astounded as I was ...
