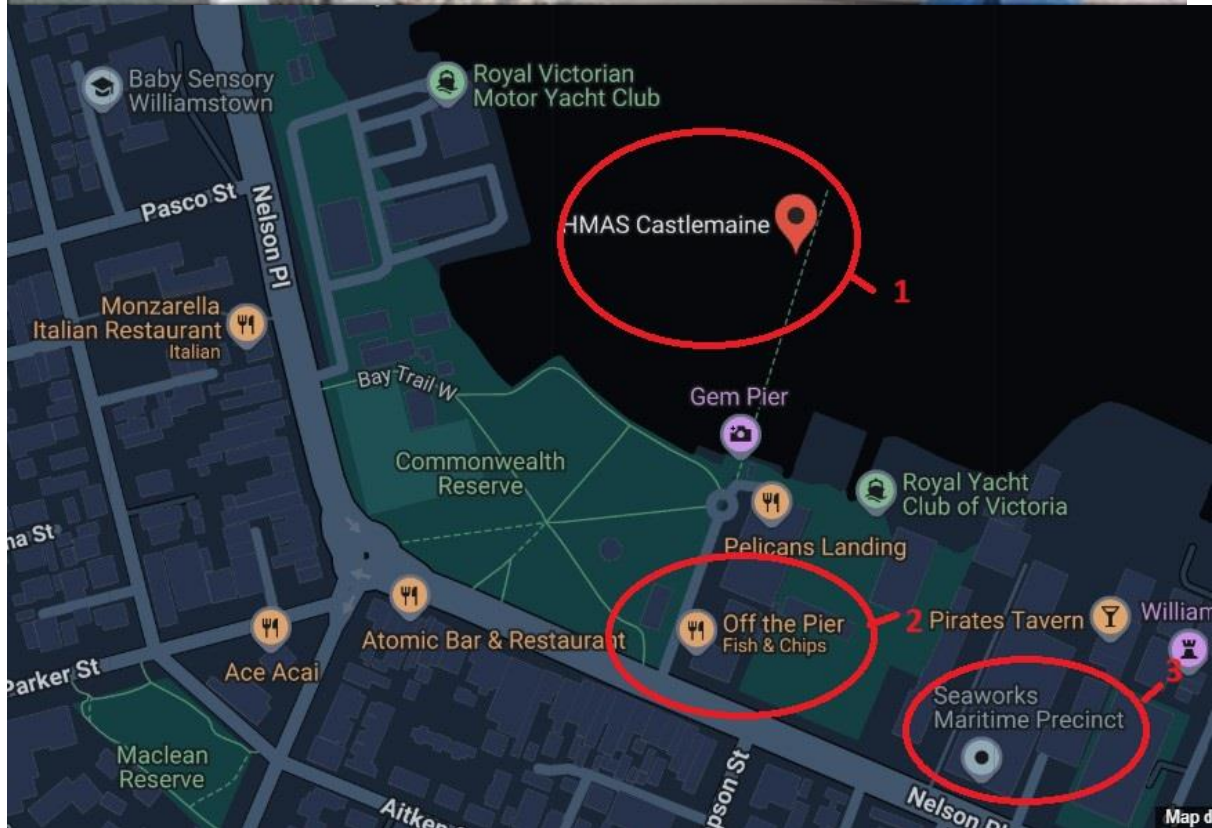


Listening to a presentation given by Garrick, enlightening.

Now for the fun. The magical trip to Tyabb Packing House followed by the Sommerville pub.





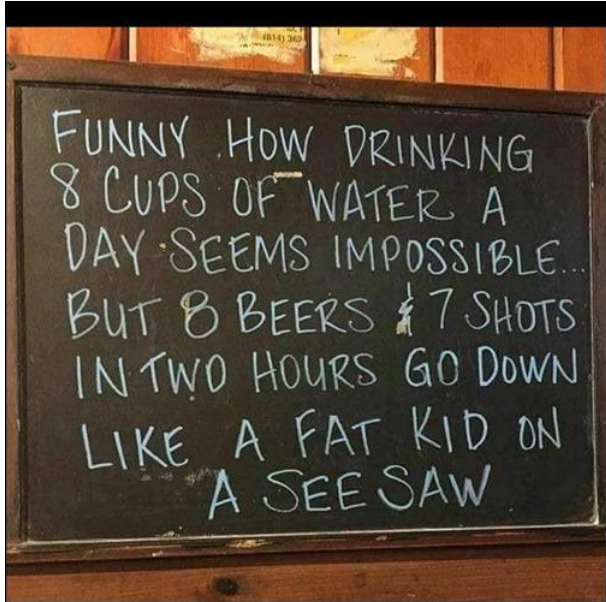

ALTONA HOMESTEAD GHOST TOURS

"And how do you know it's yours ?" shouts her father

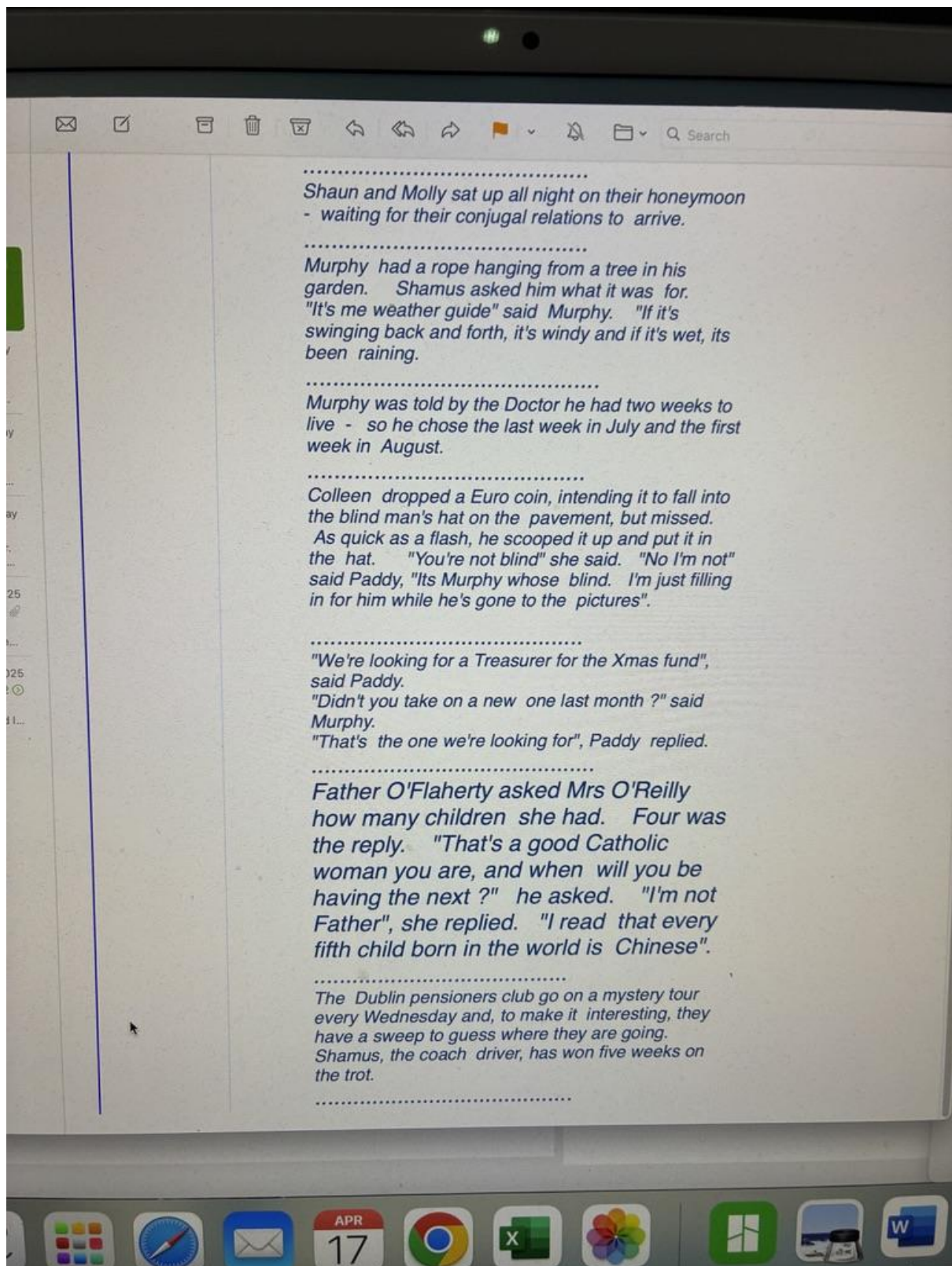
