Now for the fun. The magical trip to Tyabb Packing House followed by the Sommerville pub.







Today I started both chemotherapy and radiotherapy my mate from the Endeavour Hills Men's Shed and I spent more the 5 hours there.


The care and attention was 1st class in every way.

Time filled in by eating, reading, talking and observing.







This is a private railway on a 10-acre farm with in excess of 1000 m of track about 4 engines with carriages


I (Ian) will have to arrange the date with Ken as it takes about 6 assistants to get the steam trains going.
